## What We Do

### Job Readiness Program

CCA provides workforce development and job readiness opportunities through our strategic partnerships with multiple organizations.

We offer career assessment opportunities and internships to individuals with autism and other developmental disabilities. Participants work on dismantling electronics and sorting materials, learning vital job readiness skills in the process.

Surveys of our participants' job coaches reveal significant increases in the following skills:

- \* Working independently



### Community Outreach

Refurbished computer systems are donated to after school programs, job readiness centers, senior citizen centers and many other nonprofit organizations.

## Environmental Safety

Many devices in the computer industry contain elements that are harmful to the environment, such as lead and mercury. CCA makes every attempt to keep equipment in circulation as long as possible through refurbishment. When equipment is beyond repair it is recycled according to the "R2" practices and standards for recycling and refurbishing electronic equipment. Over 99.9% of all materials that leave our facility are either reused or recycled.
